 - d. Jessica will work with Greg (CNA President) to send another newsletter this week.
 - e. Event Rents and city staff will be at the park to drop off tables, chairs, etc. on Saturday between 7 a.m. 2 p.m.

- 2. September Member Meeting Thursday, September 12, 6-7 p.m. at the James Castle House
 - a. We'll start the meeting with brief neighborhood business, then city staff will lead tours of the Castle House and discuss neighborhood history.
- 3. Communications
 - a. Newsletters should be consistent and vetted by the board. Nate will look into automating the process for posting newsletters to the website.
